

# 2019 Performance & Demonstration Information

Thank you for your interest in performing or demonstrating at *Pangea: Cultivate Our Cultures 2019*. We are proud to present our 25th annual festival on **Saturday, November 16, 2019**. This eagerly anticipated celebration is the largest free, family-friendly celebration of cultural diversity in the FM area.

The selection process is competitive and each year, many applications are considered for a limited number of opportunities. HCSCC does not maintain a waiting list. As performance and demonstration opportunities become available, appropriate applicants will be selected from the pool of applicants submitted.

The application return deadline is **October 1, 2019**. Once we receive your application, we will confirm its receipt and ask that you be patient. You will receive a confirmation letter and a phone call to schedule a meeting with Cassie Wiste (Pangea Performance Coordinator) who will discuss the details of your performance. **Your submission will not be maintained in our files as you must apply yearly.** 

#### **FESTIVAL DATES & HOURS 2019:**

- → Festival Day: Saturday, November 16, 2019 10:00am 4:00pm
  - Performers must arrive no later than 30 minutes prior to your assigned performance.

### **PERFORMANCE STIPEND:**

- → A stipend of \$100 will be given to performances of 30 minutes or less.
- $\rightarrow$  A stipend of \$200 will be given to performances between 31 and 45 minutes.

## PERFORMANCE GUIDELINES & PERFORMER REQUIREMENTS:

- → Performances may be live music and/or dance, or demonstrate a skill
  - Dancers or singers not using live music: HCSCC must receive your music at least one day before the performance. Music may be delivered to HCSCC on a CD-ROM or flash drive. MP3 music files may also be emailed.
  - Performers are asked to bring an extra copy of your music to the event in case of emergency.
- → Performances may be 15 to 45 minutes in length. Please respect the time limit once established.
- → Performances must represent a specific country, culture, or ethnicity.
- → Traditional dress or regalia is encouraged.

→ Performers must submit a concise, written description of the performance to HCSCC by October 31, 2019.

### **HCSCC WILL PROVIDE:**

- → A sound system will be in place for the performance.
- → An adequate performance area. If your group requires special audio/visual/performance space needs, contact Cassie Wiste no later than two weeks before the event.
- → An enthusiastic and engaged audience.
- → Arrangements will be made for performers who need dressing and/or prep space. Please contact Cassie Wiste no later than two weeks before the event.
- → A performance schedule will be sent to all performers at least one week before the festival.

### **DEADLINE TO APPLY:**

- → HCSCC must receive all applications on or before **October 1, 2019.**
- → Applications must be postmarked by the deadline.
- → There is no application fee.
- → Applications are kept for one year. You must reapply each year.
